Top wines showed purity and zest of fruit. Two golds were examples of different styles, both equally valid. Judges saw some good use of yeast to add textures and layers to wine but in general yeast influences are being relied on too much.

Exhibitors need to watch VA production, sulphide, excessive leesy characters and high alcohol. Don't forget what the variety looks like in the vineyard.
