Judge's Comments

Average class with some highlights. Too many wines were plain and showing both dirty ferment characters as well as oxidation (advanced colour, VA and ethyl acetate). Winemakers should be very careful with yeast selection. Many wines were overripe with hot, alcoholic palates not backed by intensity of fruit. The few top award winning wines were lovely with purity and freshness, and in different styles.
