**What is a GI?**  
 A GI – geographical indication – is an official way of saying that the wine grapes originating from a particular location (in our case, the beautiful Adelaide Hills) have 'a given quality, reputation or other characteristic, essentially attributable to their geographical origin'. The Adelaide Hills GI was applied for and declared in 1998 and is defined, in part, by elevation – all of our vineyards are at 300m or more above sea level.
